

Big Hitter Rules

- Every player on the team plays in the field. In the infield, there can be up to five players (1st, 2nd, 3rd, shortstop, and one pitcher). The rest of the players must play in the outfield. A coach will play catcher.
- Each player must rotate a position every inning.
- During each at bat, everyone on the team bats through the order. No matter if there is 3 outs or not, however if a batter gets out, they must leave the base and go back to the team bench. The batter must hit the ball past the foul circle. The last batter of the inning must be announced. At each at bat, his/her coach will toss each player three balls, if he or she fails to hit one of those pitches, the player may then use the tee.
- There will not be any umpires at the games. Coaches will call the games.
- The games have an hour time limit or four innings.
- The home team must bat to end the game.
- Each coach is responsible for his/her team on and off the field. Do not let the kids wonder off or climb on benches or fences.
- Limit the amount of assistant coaches on the playing field. One coach is allowed between first and second base, and one is allowed in between second and third base.
