

Co-Ed Outdoor Soccer Rules

1. The game will consist of two 25 minute halves, with a 5 minute half time.
2. 7 v 7 is the rule, but you must have at least 5 players to start a game.
3. At least 1 female must be playing at all times. If this cannot be accomplished, the team without a female representative must play 1 person down.
4. Co-Ed league will referee itself, there will be a YMCA field monitor.
5. Offside will not be called, although hanging around the goal waiting to score is not appreciated.
6. No Slide Tackling allowed.
7. No overtime will be played. If a tie breaker is needed during the year end tourney, we will go straight to penalty shots.
8. All other common laws of soccer will apply.

Discipline Policy

Please bring any problems to my attention or the field monitors attention.

Policy

Each player would be given a warning for their first offense, second offense they will be asked to sit out the entire of current game, third offense will result in ejection of current game and suspension of an additional game (participate must meet with YMCA representative before they can play again), and fourth incident will result in ejection from the league without refund and reentry into any YMCA program will have to be reviewed.

**YMCA Employees can go straight to ejection of a player and discipline may vary depending on the incident.
