How to Apply:

Step 1: Retrieve a C.I.T Application from our website (hpymca.org) or stop by the Hartley Drive Family YMCA and ask our Member Services Desk Associates for assistance.

Step 2: Completely fill out the application by April 15th and turn it in to the Hartley Drive Family YMCA or email it to Ally Snuggs at asnuggs@hpymca.org.

Step 3: Acquire two personal references to complete the Reference Questionnaire. These references cannot be family members. They must be teachers, coaches or community members.

Step 4: Our mandatory group interview session on May 9th from 11:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

Step 5: After the interview, you will receive an email stating whether you were accepted into the program or not. If accepted, you will be signed up for the sessions you originally requested and your parents or guardians will be contacted to collect payment.
